**“Indias’s Largest Business plan competition”**

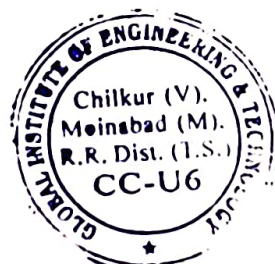

**Day 2:**

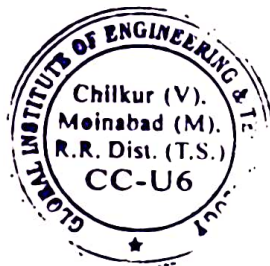
