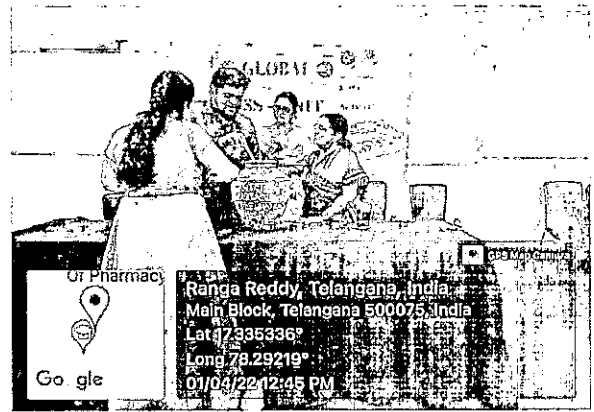
## Report on Ugadi Celebrations 2021-2022

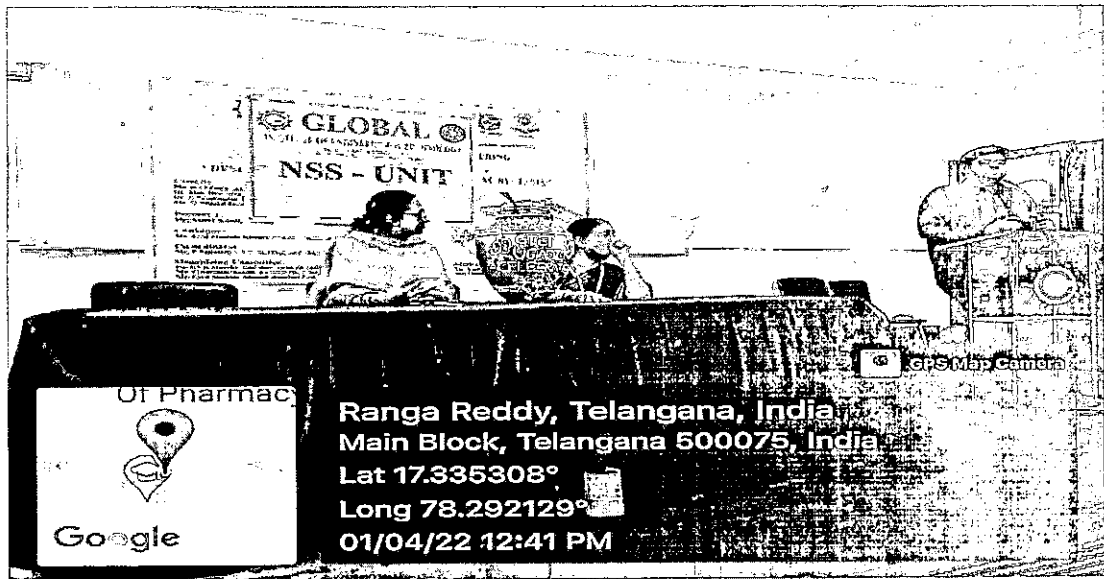




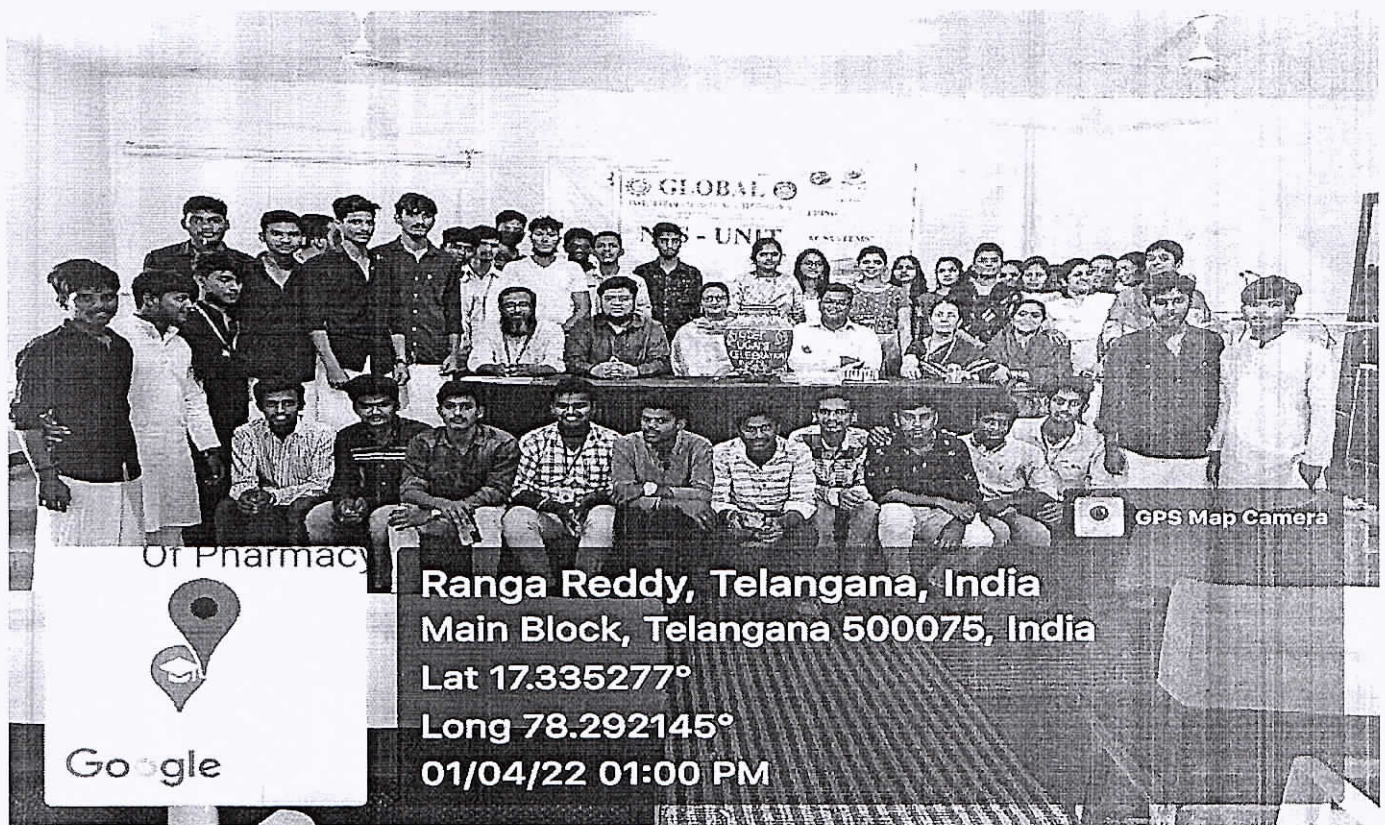
