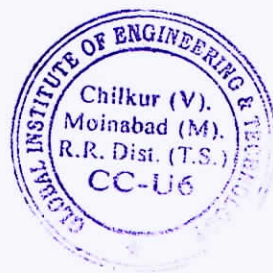

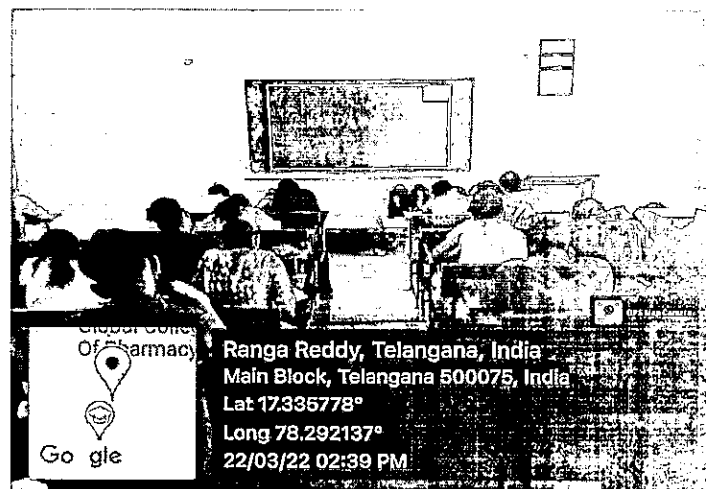

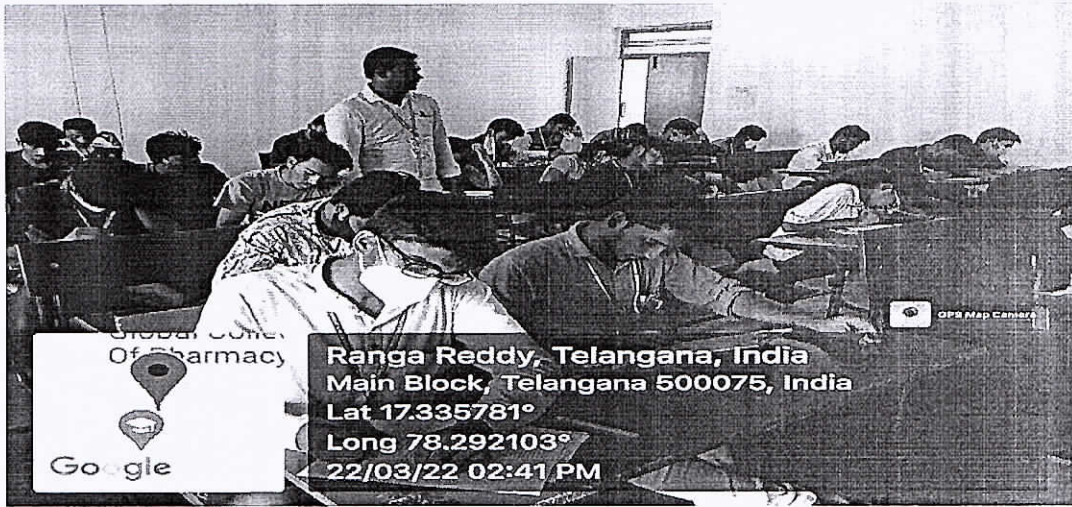
Report on Essay Writing
