


Haritha Haram Awareness - 04th August 2018




Independence Day- 15th August 2018




Swachh bharath Abhiyan 17th September 2018




Rashtriya Ektha Diwas- 31st October 2018




National Cancer Awareness Day -07th November - Kanakamamidi




Gender Equality - on 30th November 2018




National Youth Day-12th January 2019




Republic Day- 26th January 2018

19. Indian Education Festival











3. Awareness Programme on Health and Hygiene for Women








Martyrdom Day- 30th January 2016






An awareness Programme on Removal of Superstition on 08th February 2016





4. Health Camp




